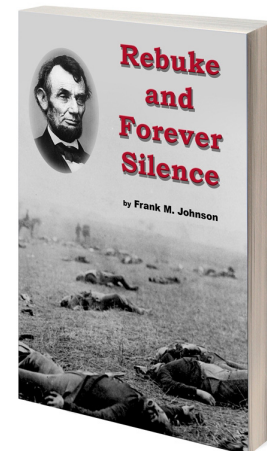

Historian and Author, Frank M. Johnson is a 6th generation Texan who has studied and researched both Texas and American History for most of his life. Raised in Liberty County, Texas, Mr. Johnson graduated from Cleveland High School in Cleveland, Texas prior to attending the University of Houston. He has been a resident of Montgomery County for the past 30 years and is a member of the board of directors of the Montgomery County Historical Commission and the Texas Heritage Society. In addition to publishing three books, Mr. Johnson has written numerous articles for local newspapers, magazines and other publications.

At the Museum event on Saturday, May 20th you will be able purchase his newest book, "Rebuke and Forever Silence" and have it personally autographed. This newest publication focuses on President Abraham Lincoln and his Republican Party during a sixteen month period between July of 1863 and the U. S. Presidential election in November of 1864. It also gives a shocking account of America's history leading up to the events during that period and explains the impact that those events have had on our country. Mr. Johnson will also be available to answer any questions that you might have about the new book or any of his other publications.
